THAT the County Judge of Lubbock County, Texas is hereby authorized and directed to accept for and on behalf of the County of Lubbock one certain Street and Public Use Dedication Deed (the "Dedication Deed") in connection with a 0.038 acre parcel located in Section 25, Block 20, Lubbock County, Texas, being a portion of Lot 13, Block 1, Woodrow, a Subdivision in the Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Block 20, Lubbock County, Texas, according to the map, plat and/or dedication deed thereof recorded in Volume 220, Page 164, Deed Records, Lubbock County, Texas ("Parcel 173") to be utilized for the roadway expansion project, commonly known as the "Woodrow Road Project," and all related documents. Further, the County Judge of Lubbock County, Texas is hereby authorized and directed to authorize and make payment in the amount of \$6,171.00 as consideration for the acquisition of the Dedication Deed at the closing of Parcel 173. Said Dedication Deed is attached hereto and incorporated in this Resolution as if fully set forth herein and shall be included in the minutes of this Commissioner's Court.

RE: Discussion of Right-of-Way Acquisition Costs for the Woodrow Road Project, Parcel 173, Gabriel Madrigal and Rachel Madrigal

Lubbock County is acquiring the necessary right-of-way and easements for Woodrow Road from FM 1730 (Slide Road) to SL 493. The cost for the Street and Public Use Dedication Deed for Parcel 173, Gabriel Madrigal and Rachel Madrigal, is \$6,171.00, with estimated closing costs in the amount of \$781.88 (+/- 20%) for a total estimated acquisition cost of \$6,952.88.

Funding for this acquisition is as follows:
\$6,952.88 to come from Woodrow Road, Auditor #B11003.
