


CAPROCK JAZZ ACADEMY AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM PROPOSAL

Overview

Lubbock Roots Historical Arts Council was established in 1978, as a 501 (c) 3 organization to promote the arts to the people of the community and surrounding cities.

Roots are the host for the annual fundraisers; Caprock Jazz Festival, Jazzy Christmas Concert, and Jazz in The Park. These events are essential to support scholarships and help to sustain the museum's essential needs.

The grant will be used to help fund the concerts and the Caprock Jazz Academy and scholarships.

The layout of the program.

This pilot program will officially launch in the fall of 2023. We will meet Mondays. Students will come straight to the academy after they get out of school. Release times of school are staggered. The first block of time will be for individual practice and one-on-one instruction and snack. The second block of time we will have Jazz history curriculum. The third block of time will be ensemble rehearsal. The last block is for cleanup.

Goals

The mission is to teach young students to understand jazz and the history of jazz. As well as how to play and understand a selective instrument when performing.

The Caprock Jazz Academy will serve secondary students that are local and in surrounding towns.

The Caprock Jazz Academy will educate students about jazz and how to appreciate the art of jazz.

All students will be given the opportunity to showcase their music skills at the Caprock Jazz Festival, Jazzy Christmas Concert, and Jazz in The Park, sponsored by the Lubbock Roots Historical Arts Council.
