Good morning LCPW,

It was brought to my attention by USPS that a family land-share located in west-central Lubbock Co continues to expand (LCAD #R50146). Initial structures were assigned as units of 3902 PR 1240, however, 2024 imagery shows three new structures. Because of this, re-addressing measures will now need to be taken to establish a private road to serve the six current structures, and an unknown number to follow.

If you would please approve the use of <u>PRIVATE ROAD 6820</u>, I will begin the process of re-assigning existing addresses (and assign new ones) along a block range rather than by unit number. I have spoke to the family's translator and made them aware of the following:

- 1. purchase & installation of intersection signage will be at their expense, given that it is on private land and not County ROW, and
- 2. private road maintenance will not be the responsibility of Lubbock County
