

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 251.151 and 251.155 of the Texas Transportation Code, the Commissioners Court may regulate traffic by adopting regulations establishing a system of traffic control devices;

WHEREAS, NW and SE corners of 151st Street and Kelsey Avenue and NE and SW corners of 153rd Street and Kelsey Avenue, Precinct 1 are both county roads maintained by Lubbock County, Texas, and is therefore a county road or highway outside an urban district and not a highway numbered by this state or the United States; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF LUBBOCK, TEXAS:

THAT the Commissioners Court has determined that the installation of stop signs at the intersection of NW and SE corners of 151st St. and Kelsey Avenue and NE and SW corners of 153rd St. and Kelsey Avenue, creating a two-way stop intersection, is necessary for public safety

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF LUBBOCK, TEXAS:

THAT the Commissioners Court does hereby authorize the placement, construction, and/or installation of the stop signs in accordance with this Resolution
