Dear Judge Parrish and County Commissioners,

I am writing this letter in my role as the Interim Division Director of Public Works for the City of Lubbock, as well as the City's Director of Traffic, to formally request a decrease in the posted speed limit on County Road 7600 (Woodrow Road) from FM 179 eastward to the segment of CR 7600 that is currently posted at 50 mph near Liberty High School. This roadway has experienced significant growth and increased traffic in recent years due to growth along Woodrow Road. The current speed limit no longer reflects the roadway's needs and presents increasing safety concerns for residents, motorists, and pedestrians. Lower speed limits increase driver reaction times and significantly improve stopping distances, thus reducing the risk and severity of traffic conflicts.

A reduced speed limit combined with appropriate signage will encourage safety and reduce crash risks and severity, which will improve overall quality of life for residents along this corridor. Thank you for your attention to this matter and for your continued commitment to public safety.
