RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 251.151 and 251.155 of the Texas Transportation Code, the Commissioners Court may regulate traffic by adopting regulations establishing a system of traffic control devices;

WHEREAS, 151st Street and Kelsey Avenue are both county roads maintained by Lubbock County, Texas, and is therefore a county road or highway outside an urban district and not a highway numbered by this state or the United States; and
