



I have been employed with the Lubbock County Sheriff's Office since August 15th, 2016 as a Detention Officer, and was promoted to a Staff Sergeant position on April 30th, 2022. I obtained my Basic Jailer's License in May of 2017 following the completion of Jail School and Defensive Tactics. I was a member of the Detention Response Team (DRT) from January of 2018 to July of 2022. I completed the Basic Firearm School at the Lubbock County Sheriff's Office Shooting Range in March of 2018.
