

**LUBBOCK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT RESOLUTION
APPROVING SUBMISSION
OF LUBBOCK COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY
BORDER PROSECUTION UNIT-TAG PROJECT GRANT
(BPU GRANT 3805103—09/01/2023 to 08/31/2025)**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Lubbock County that the Lubbock County District Attorney Border Prosecution Unit-TAG Project Grant (BPU 3805103) be operated for the period of September 1, 2023, to August 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County agrees to provide all applicable matching funds for said project as required by the Homeland Security Grants Division of the Governor’s Office through the applicable grant application and guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor’s grant funds, Lubbock County assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County designates the Honorable Curtis Parrish, County Judge of Lubbock County, as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of Lubbock County, Texas, as the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County approves submission of the grant application for the Lubbock County District Attorney Border Prosecution Unit-TAG Project Grant (BPU 3805103) to the Office of the Governor.


