**WHEREAS:** The South Plains Coalition for Child Abuse Prevention in collaboration with Covenant Children's Hospital, are hosting a kick-off and conference to bring together agencies, healthcare providers, law enforcement and concerned individuals to create awareness, provide education, and initiate efforts to prevent child abuse and neglect; and,
