

**RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 251.151 and 251.155 of the Texas Transportation Code, the Commissioners Court may regulate traffic by adopting regulations establishing a system of traffic control devices;

WHEREAS, the intersection of 151<sup>st</sup> Street and Kelsey Avenue, Southbound of Kelsey Avenue, Southbound of 151<sup>st</sup> Street, Northbound of 151<sup>st</sup> Street in Buena Vista, Precinct 1 are county roads maintained by Lubbock County, Texas, and is therefore a county road or highway outside an urban district and not a highway numbered by this state or the United States; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF LUBBOCK, TEXAS:

THAT the Commissioners Court has determined that the installation of stop signs at the intersection of 151<sup>st</sup> St. and Kelsey Avenue, Southbound of Kelsey Avenue, Southbound of 151<sup>st</sup> Street, Northbound of 151<sup>st</sup> Street in Buena Vista, Precinct 1, creating a four-way stop intersection, is necessary for public safety

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF LUBBOCK, TEXAS:

THAT the Commissioners Court does hereby authorize the placement, construction, and/or installation of the stop signs in accordance with this Resolution
