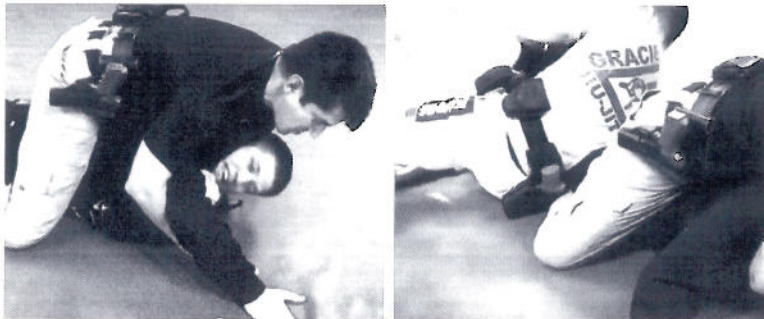

- 47.9% of officers injured or killed in a line of duty is attributed to loss of their weapon

- 95% of all confrontations and fights end up on the ground.
- Current Defensive Tactical Programs available are ineffective and officers resort to using brute strength and sheer will power to overcome a suspect/criminal, resulting in potential loss of their weapon or serious injury to the officer.

- Automatic rapid response needs to be made in an altercation. Offensive vs. defensive mindset is emphasized before, during and after the altercation.

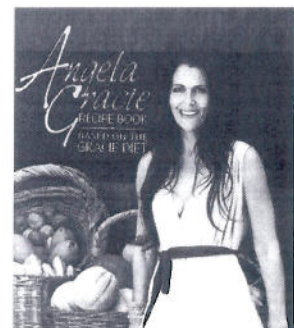
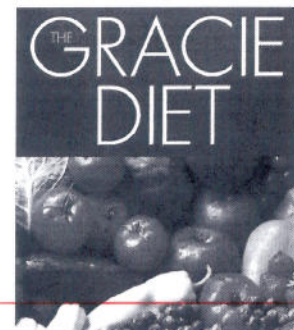

The G.R.A.C.I.E. course is a week-long course designed for instructors or whole departments. The course is 6 hours per day for 5 consecutive days. At the end of the course instructors must be able to demonstrate and teach the moves in order to receive certification. Certification is valid for one year however re-certification can be obtained in a 2-day condensed course.
