Dear Judge and Commissioners,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing in my capacity as a member of the Lubbock City Council representing District 5 to respectfully request your consideration and support in reducing the current speed limit along Woodrow Road from Slide Road west to approximately Alcove Avenue and/or FM 179.

Over the past several years, this corridor has experienced significant growth and development. What was once largely a rural roadway now serves expanding residential neighborhoods, new housing construction, and increasing commercial development. The City of Lubbock's boundaries now extend to and along portions of this stretch, and the character of the roadway has shifted from open rural transit to a developing mixed-use corridor with daily neighborhood traffic.

We have received numerous concerns from residents regarding serious traffic incidents along this portion of Woodrow Road, including high-speed collisions, severe injuries, and fatalities. As development continues and traffic volume increases, the current posted speed limit no longer appears aligned with the evolving roadway conditions.

For the safety of our shared constituents, I respectfully request that the Commissioner's Court consider reducing the speed limit to 50 mph along this stretch.

Our shared priority is protecting the lives of the families who now call this area home, while also supporting responsible growth and development in southwest Lubbock County. I look forward to collaborating with you to ensure this corridor remains safe for residents, business owners, and commuters alike.
