RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Lubbock County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Lubbock County that the State Homeland Security Grants Program – Competitive National Priority Area Projects Grant Program for Lubbock County – Elections Security Enhancement to be operated for the 2026 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Texas Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grants Program grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Lubbock County Commissioner Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grant Program funds, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grant Program in full.

WHEREAS, the Lubbock County Commissioner Court designates Judge Curtis Parrish as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of Lubbock County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lubbock County Commissioner Court approves submission of the grant application for the Lubbock County – Elections Security Enhancement to the Office of the Governor.
