ABOUT TRITICH

This updated Ritualistic and Occult Crime Scene Investigations course is a comprehensive workshop designed to provide crime scene analysts, law enforcement professionals, and other investigators with an extensive understanding of crime scenes containing symbolic and unfamiliar evidence. Investigators will be introduced to the types of crimes most often associated with occult activity, crime scene clues, investigation strategies, and an overview of active groups. Crime scenes, forensic and symbolic evidence involving the ritual practices of Satanism, Santeria, Voodoo, Palo Mayombe, and the Goth, Vampire, and Fetish Scenes will be presented. New to the course is a block of instruction dealing with ritualistic practices of human traffickers. Crime scene and autopsy images will demonstrate forensic and symbolic evidence specific to particular groups. Case studies include ritual sexual abuse, animal sacrifice, ritual homicides and human trafficking.

The portion of the course covering ritual homicides will provide the student with an extensive understanding of homicides involving symbolic evidence and trauma. Attendees will be introduced to a variety of unfamiliar injuries, excessive mutilation, unusual trauma, and symbolic crime scene evidence. Uncommon ceremonies, rites of passage, and initiations specific to particular groups will be described. Attendees will also be educated on a variety of unusual activities such as cutting, branding, blood drinking, and body mutilation. The significance of magical and occult ideologies as a motivation for ritual murders is described. The prevalence of child victims and invenile perpetrators is addressed. Distinctions between

counter forensic measures and ideological motivations for disfigurement and dismemberment are described in detail Crime scene and autopsy images will demonstrate forensic and symbolic exidence specific to particular groups. Numerous case studies will be presented.

The block of instruction that covers human trafficking provides the attendee with an overview of human traffickers, sex traffickers, and pedophiles and their use of various types of tattoos, symbols, emojis, codes, and terms to recognize one another, to distinguish their sexual and age preferences and to advertise services. This training includes pedophile political activist movements, designated holidays, the glorification of pedophilia in art and literature and the academic defense of pedophilia. Other identifiers of child sex trafficking such as the selling and distributing of child sex dolls and robots will be presented. This session will prepare the attendee to recognize symbols, atypical evidence, and paraphernalia found at crime scenes, during the execution of search warrants, and digital evidence (such as social media) examinations.

This Ritualistic and Accult Crime Scene Investigations workshop includes a half-day practical exercise where students will be exposed to actual ritualistic activity or realistic recreations so they can investigate a scenario to its logical conclusion. Students will also take part in a tour of commercial businesses, such as "botanicas," where accountements and paraphernalia used by ritualistic groups are bought and sold (Based on geographic availability.)

Dawn Perlmutter, Ph.D., Director of the Symbol Intelligence Group is considered one of the leading subject matter experts (SME) in the areas of symbols, symbolic methodologies, unfamiliar quetoms and ritualistic crimes. In her SME capacity, she noutinely provides law enforcement investigators, defense and intelligence agencies with specialized information to assist in operations, investigation and analysis. She has advised police departments, and prosecutors offices on numerous cases of ritual homicide and presented expert witness testimony on ritualistic crimes.

Dr. Perlmutter is an adjunct Professor in the Forensic Medicine Program at Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine. She is the author of two books, Investigating Religious Terrorism and Ritualistic Crimes and Symbols of Terrorism as well as numerous publications on ritual violence.

Dr. Perlmutter has been interviewed for many documentaries, newspapers and newscasts. She holds a Doctor of Philosophy from New York University and a Masters Degree from The American University, Washington, D.C. Dawn Perlmutter is an active member of The American Investigative Society of Cold Cases (AISOCC) and The Vidoco Society, an exclusive crime-solving organization that solves cold case homicides.
