



RESOLUTION

ORDER AUTHORIZING TEXAS INDEPENDENCE DAY FIREWORKS SALES

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Texas Independence Day; and

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of February 2022, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Texas Independence Day period beginning February 25, 2022, and ending at midnight March 2, 2022, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, March 2, 2022, whichever is earlier.
- b. Restricted Fireworks, which are defined as skyrockets with sticks and missiles with fins. Violation of this order is a Class C misdemeanor
