

WHEREAS, the 88th Legislature enacted Senate Bill 268 effective September 1, 2023 designating a portion of Farm-to-Marker Road 40 in Lubbock County between County Road 3300 and County Road 3800 as "The Maines Brothers Band Highway"; and

WHEREAS, the Lubbock Arts Alliance has made a funding request to Lubbock County in the amount of \$6,189.00 to install signage along "The Maines Brothers Band Highway"; and

WHEREAS, Local Government Code, Section 381.004, and Texas Property Code, Section 74.602 authorized the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts to allocate a portion of the unclaimed capital credits received from electric cooperatives back to the counties in the cooperatives' service areas; and

WHEREAS, the uses of capital credits may be used for the encouragement, promotion, improvement and application of the arts; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LUBBOCK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT that the Court does hereby find the use of the capital credits an applicable use for signage along "The Maines Brothers Band Highway" for promotion of the arts in Lubbock County and hereby approves the funding request by the Lubbock Arts Alliance in the amount of \$6,189.00 to place signage along Farm-to-Market 40 between County Road 3300 and county Road 3800 identifying "The Maines Brothers Band Highway"
