



RESOLUTION

IN SUPPORT OF THE STATE DESIGNATION OF THE FIRST RESPONDERS MEMORIAL LOOP

WHEREAS, First Responders - those engaged in law enforcement, firefighting, and emergency medical services - provide invaluable services by taking responsibility for the health and safety of our Lubbock County communities; and

WHEREAS, through the years, the people of Lubbock County have experienced, far too often, the tragedy of a First Responder who has given what President Lincoln called the "last full measure of devotion" and,

WHEREAS, we not only honor their memory, but also reinforce the values of bravery, selflessness, and community that they embodied, and ensure that the legacy of our fallen First Responders continues to inspire and lead future generations; and,

WHEREAS, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court requests the Texas Legislature to name a portion of State Highway Loop 88 in Lubbock County as

"The First Responders Memorial Loop"


as a fitting tribute and lasting reminder of those dedicated public servants who have fallen in the line of duty; and,






