RE: 10-27-2025 Agenda Item: Consider and approve a Resolution in Support of Fiscal Year 2026 Other Victim Assistance Grants (2nd Offering) Application to the Office of the Attorney General.

The Office of Dispute Resolution (ODR), through its designation as the Domestic Relations Office for Lubbock County, is requesting approval of a resolution of support to apply to the Office of the Attorney General for an "Other Victim Assistance Grant." The funding, if approved, would be used for supervised visitation and neutral exchange services.

ODR has provided supervised visitation and neutral exchange services for more than ten years. This court-ordered service is authorized to be provided by the Domestic Relations Office through Texas Family Code Chapter 203. The amount requested is a total of \$48,880 for a period of 12 months. This grant opportunity has no match requirement.
