

**LUBBOCK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT RESOLUTION  
APPROVING SUBMISSION OF THE LUBBOCK COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE  
TEXAS ANTI-GANG CENTER LUBBOCK GRANT #3401110  
(10/1/2026 – 09/30/2027)**

**WHEREAS**, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Lubbock County that the Lubbock County Sheriff’s Office Texas Anti-Gang Center Lubbock Grant be operated for the period October 1, 2026, to September 30, 2027; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, The Lubbock County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court designates the County Judge as the grantee’s authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

**WHEREAS**, the Lubbock County Commissioners Court designates Kathy Williams, the Lubbock County Auditor, as the grantee’s financial officer. The financial officer is given the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the applicant agency

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that The Lubbock County Commissioners Court approves acceptance of the grant for the Lubbock County Sheriff’s Office Peace Officer Mental Wellness Grant from the Office of the Governor.
