SECTION 179D FORM OF ALLOCATION ENERGY EFFICIENT COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS TAX DEDUCTION

The Section 179D Energy Efficient Commercial Buildings Deduction was enacted by Congress as part of the Energy Policy Act of 2005, and later made permanent as part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, H.R. 133. The intent of the tax code section is to incentivize energy efficient construction and upgrades to the interior lighting systems, HVAC and hot water systems, and building envelope systems of commercial buildings in the United States. The Inflation Reduction Act of 2022 expanded the buildings eligible for evaluation to include tax exempt entities including, but not limited to, religious institutions, private universities, and tribal owned buildings. These new provisions allow tax exempt building owners to allocate the 179D deduction to designers. A designer is a person that creates the technical specifications for the installation of energy efficient commercial building property.

JSA Architects qualifies for the 179D allocation based on the following activity:
