This application for \$15,000 was approved by Commissioners' Court on July 11, 2022. The narrative submitted for the application is below. The Foundation has now awarded the full amount.

“We discussed Supervised Visitation services during the budget hearing and now have an opportunity to begin expanding how we assist parents. The plan is to involve Texas Tech University Vice Provost, Dr. Elizabeth Trejos-Castillo, and her students/colleagues. They will observe selected high-conflict parents to develop parenting plans and accessible resources. If funded, the Texas Bar Foundation grant would provide graduate students and faculty stipends for observing a parent’s interaction with their child or children. Our application, for \$15,000, is for observation time only and does not include any salary compensation for County or Texas Tech personnel.”
